Students can only enrol in Culture Subjectivities and Schooling (TEAC 7023) when they have achieved 120 credit points in their overall program. Students can only enrol in the other three subjects in the minor; Aboriginal, Education: Paste, Present and Future (TEAC7156), Primary Human Society and its Environment (TEAC7092) and Understanding and Teaching Children (TEAC7149) when they have achieved 160 credit points in their overall program.
