Program Structure

Students may exit with the Associate Degree in Social Science on completion of 160 credit points of Social Science subjects. These subjects should comprise:

- 60 credit points from the Social Science core
- 60 credit points of focus subjects from one or more of the approved social science majors and/or elective minors which are listed below, and
- 40 credit points of flexible subjects.

Of the 160 credit points completed, no more than 80 credit points should be at Level 1 and at least 60 credit points should be at Level 2 or 3.
