Students can only enrol in the other three subjects in the minor; TEAC 7156 Aboriginal, Education: Past, Present and Future, TEAC 7092 Primary Human Society and its Environment and TEAC 7161 Educational Psychology for Learning and Teaching when they have achieved 160 credit points in their overall program.
