Students have the option to graduate with core project management skills only (Graduate Certificate) or to continue to progress with a Masters degree.

Graduates will possess the capabilities to consider project management life cycles for specific domains, create project plans involving effective control on scope, time, cost and quality, manage resources, procurement, risks, stakeholders, and communications in project settings, and coordinate all elements of a project to seek project success with predefined goals being met.
