Description This capstone subject provides students with the opportunity to synthesise and apply the theoretical and operational knowledge developed throughout the Sport Management major. Students will engage in an applied research project in collaboration with an industry partner, addressing a real-world issue within the sport sector. Through a process of consultation, critical analysis, and evidence-based problem solving, students will develop and deliver practical outcomes for the partner organisation. The subject culminates in a professional presentation of findings, allowing students to demonstrate their capacity for independent inquiry, strategic thinking, and industry engagement.
